STAGE 1 WATER SUPPLY EMERGENCY AND PERMANENT WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

STAGE 1 RESTRICTIONS

A State of Emergency proclaimed that eight Southern California counties, including Los Angeles County, are experiencing severe drought conditions. As a result of these conditions, the La Puente Valley County Water District Board of Directors has declared a STAGE 1 WATER SUPPLY EMERGENCY and has also adopted PERMANENT WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES.



STAGE 1 RESTRICTIONS

- OUTDOOR WATERING IS LIMITED TO 3 DAYS PER WEEK BETWEEN 5 P.M. AND 9 A.M. ON MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, AND FRIDAY
- Repair leaks within 5 days after receiving notice from LPVCWD



PERMANENT WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES



- No outdoor irrigation from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- · No irrigation runoff to sidewalks/streets
- · No watering public street medians



 Sweep sidewalks, driveways and hardscapes instead of hosing them down



· Check for leaks and repair them regularly



- Option to decline daily linens at lodging establishments
- Serving drinking water, other than upon request, shall be prohibited in eating and drinking establishments

OTHER WATERING RESTRICTIONS

- Use only recirculating water in decorative fountains
- Turn sprinklers off during rain
- No watering for 48 hours after rainfall
- Use a shut-off nozzle when washing cars
